1. Call your US Senators and Representative. Tell them: *I am extremely worried about the DOGE cuts to the Social Security Administration. Our Hot Springs SSA office has been terrific. Cutting staff and shuttering offices will surely result in missed Social Security payments. Many Arkansans will suffer dramatically without Social Security! Refuse to pass any spending bill that does not restore SSA to full capacity!*

Call both the DC office and the state office. Be sure to state your name and town, even if you are leaving a message.

2. Call your state senator, representative & the governor's office (501-682-2345) opposing **HB1646**. This bill sponsored by Richard McGrew and Matt McKee, seeks to revoke the teaching licenses of school librarians if children check out material mentioning sexuality. This bill would require such materials to be stored in locked rooms. (The bill does not apply to McKee's homeschooled children.)

Tell them: *I am strongly opposed to HB1646. This bill is vindictive and unnecessary, especially in the state with the 2nd highest teen pregnancy rate in the USA. This bill does not protect children, but stomps on free speech.*
